Terms and Conditions

1. A prize of a guided visit to the University of Reading Farm will be awarded to the competition winner.
2. Winners may bring two friend or family members with them on the tour. Those under 18 years old must be accompanied by an adult.
3. The date of the visit is to be confirmed and will be arranged to suit the competition winners and staff at the farm.
4. The competition is open to any member of the public. Only one entry per person is permitted.
5. Entries should be emailed to info@rfi.ac.uk or photos posted to either twitter or Instagram which tag the Institute accounts (@rosfrankinst or @rosalindfranklininst, respectively).
6. The competition closes at 23.59 on 11th July 2022. The winners will be notified in July 2022, depending on their method of entry they will be notified by e-mail or DM.
7. All winners are responsible for arranging their own transport to and from the University of Reading Farm.
8. Entrants must agree to follow the guide's instructions at all times. Failure to do so may pose a health and safety risk and may result in winners being asked to leave the farm immediately.
9. By entering, entrants will be deemed to have agreed to be bound by these rules and any additional conditions made known to them by the Institute. The competition organisers reserve the right to exclude an entry from the competition at any time and in its absolute discretion, if the organisers have reason to believe that an entrant has breached these rules.
10. The Rosalind Franklin Institute reserves the right to cancel this competition or alter any of the rules at any stage, if deemed necessary in its opinion, and if circumstances arise outside of its control.
11. If the winner is unable to be contacted after reasonable attempts have been made; Rosalind Franklin Institute reserves the right either to offer the prize to a runner up, or to re-offer the prize in any future competition.
